## **RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CHILDREN'S IMAGINARIUM DUCK REGATTA**

Presented by the Children's Imaginarium, License #R0042901-A-65693, a charitable organization under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. It is sponsored by and all net proceeds benefit the Children's Imaginarium, 195 N 2nd St, Wausau, WI 54403.

1. A maximum of 1,000 ducks will be entered in the race. Chances of winning depends on the total number of qualified entries.
2. To enter, eligible entrants must purchase a raffle chance ("adopt a duck") at \$20 each or 6 ducks for \$100 by purchasing an adoption ticket at either the Children's Imaginarium or at various Wausau events.
3. All ducks entered are and shall remain the property of the Children's Imaginarium, once the ducks are launched, they are on their own. No attempt to free or interfere with any duck is permitted by spectators unless deemed necessary by the- race committee. Sponsor reserves the right to manually maneuver rubber ducks along the course if necessary.
4. The Duck Regatta will take place at Wausau Whitewater Park, 200 River Drive, Wausau, WI 54403, at approximately 4:15 pm on Sunday, July 14, 2024. All adopted ducks will be included in the duck race for monetary prizes.
5. The race committee will establish the race course. The Children's Imaginarium reserves the right to postpone or reschedule the race or to determine the winners by random drawing in the event of inclement weather or other circumstances beyond their control.
6. A number will be marked to the bottom of each duck relating to the number on the adoption paper ticket. The person's name appearing on the adoption papers corresponding to the first 10 ducks in order of finish as collected by the designated duck catcher will be awarded prizes.
7. Winners need not be present to win and will be notified by phone. Positive identification will be required to claim any prize(s). Winners will be announced on the Rubber Duck Regatta page of the Children's Imaginarium at [www.childreanimaginarium.org](http://www.childreanimaginarium.org) as soon as all of the winners have been verified.
8. Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st place - \$2000, 2nd place - \$1000, 3rd place - \$700, 4th place - \$500, 5th through 10th place - \$100.
9. By entering, entrants release the Children's Imaginarium and its officers, directors and staff and other related entities from any and all liability with respect to prizes. All decisions and interpretations of rules and regulations will be made by the Children's Imaginarium Duck Regatta Race Committee and its judgment is final.
10. By entering, winners consent to the promotional use of their names and likenesses without additional compensation.
